- Jester scrubs: Suhas Bharadwaj
 - o damaged scrubs (holes, etc...) are still in circulation
 - has been issue for long time and no progress has been made in efforts to remove old scrubs
 - machine scrubs typically mandatory for ~12 weeks in M3 year
 - \circ suggestion for SGA leadership to sit down with Dr. Knight to discuss scrubs,
 - changing/locker room concerns, etc...
 - (?) possible to have one person from Student Affairs who is Sentara POC and serves as liaison between EVMS students and Sentara to ensure basic needs met i.e... room to change, scrubs without holes, tour of facility
 - lack of communication between EVMS and Sentara preceptors unaware of students being scheduled, etc...
